We are an established Roman Catholic independent school and nursery for boys and girls from the ages of 3 to 11, and part of the worldwide network of Ursuline schools. We offer a first-class independent education and wrap-around childcare in our safe, secure, happy and highly successful school.

At The Ursuline Prep School we aim to give each child the best possible start in life. As well as having extremely rigorous academic standards along with high expectations of behaviour, we provide pastoral support appropriate to the needs of each unique child in our care.

The National Curriculum provides the basis for our programmes of study, but these are enhanced and enriched to reflect the calibre of our pupils. Specialist teachers teach music, PE and MFL.

We encourage pupils to participate in the extensive range of extracurricular activities such as speech and drama, ballet, Irish dancing, Bollywood and Mandarin and a wide selection of musical instrumental tuition.

In addition, we provide a number of free after school activities each day for the children to participate in such as choir, Science Club and Maths Club.

Our fees include Breakfast Club and After School Club. All are held on site and are manned by regular school staff.

# Admissions Procedures for The Ursuline Preparatory School and Nursery Ilford

To apply for a place, please complete the enclosed registration form and return it to school together with a non-refundable £100 registration fee and a copy of your child's birth certificate. If you are applying for a place in the Nursery or Reception please also supply proof of your address. This is a requirement of the London Borough of Redbridge in respect of Early Years Funding.

Please note that children are accepted into our Nursery from the <u>term</u> after their third birthday, on a full-time basis with 3 entry points: September, January and April. The parents of children already in our nursery are invited to apply for a place in our Reception class the January before their child is due to start Reception which is the <u>September</u> after their fourth birthday. Children not in our nursery may apply any time.

You may, at any point, arrange to come into the school for a short guided tour where we will be happy to answer any questions you may have.

On receipt of your registration form and fee, an assessment session will be arranged for your child in the class of your child's current peers.

Subsequent to this you may receive a written offer of a place at the school. Enclosed with that letter would be another form which would need to be completed and returned, together with an entrance fee of £300 if the place is for Nursery or £650 for our Prep school.

For Nursery places, £100 of the entrance fee is refundable if your child leaves our school on the last day of the summer term before going to another school for Reception in the following September (subject to there being no outstanding bills or charges and subject to a full term's notice of withdrawal having been given if applicable). The balance of £200 will be retained by the school (to cover set up and administration costs).

If, however, you choose to apply for a place in our Prep School Reception class upwards then a total of £650 is requested (ie an additional £350 if you are continuing on from Nursery). Only on receipt of that entrance fee is your place confirmed. £400 of the £650 entrance fee is refundable if your child completes Year 6 (subject to there being no outstanding bills or charges) but non-refundable if they leave before that. £250 will be retained by the school (to cover set up and administration costs).

Please note, registration fees and entrance fees <u>cannot be paid</u> using the Government's Tax-Free Childcare Scheme.

## Fees include:

- An all-inclusive 37 weeks per year, up to 55 hours per week
- 7.30am to 6.30pm. Children MUST be in school from 8.50am until 3.15pm for Nursery and 3.20pm for Years 1&2, 3.25pm Years 3&4 and £.30pm for Year 5&6. Use of Breakfast Club from 7.30am and After School Club until 6.30pm is optional.
- Breakfast, lunch and after-school snacks.
